

Getting search results from Scopus in EndNote

You can automatically export bibliographical data from Scopus into EndNote. Here is how it goes:

Step 1 - Download Scopus Filter

- Download the Scopus Filter from the EndNote website: <http://endnote.com/downloads/filters>
- Information provider must be: **Elsevier**
- Download the **Scopus** File

- Open it with your EndNote programme

Step 2 - Search in the Scopus database

- Enter a search statement in Scopus
- From the result list, check those which you consider as relevant.
- Once all records are marked, click on Export

Step 3 - Save the results to a RIS file

- Change the Export format to RIS format (Reference Manager, ProCite, EndNote).
- Select Complete format in Output and click on Export

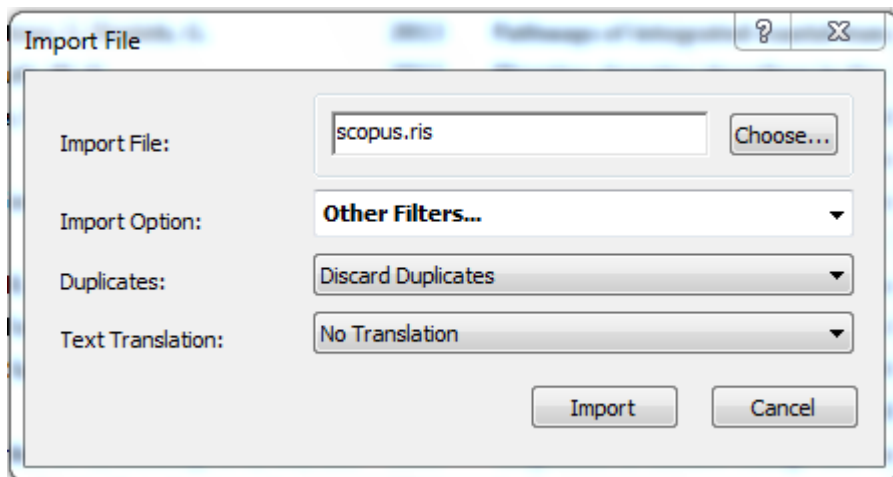

Export

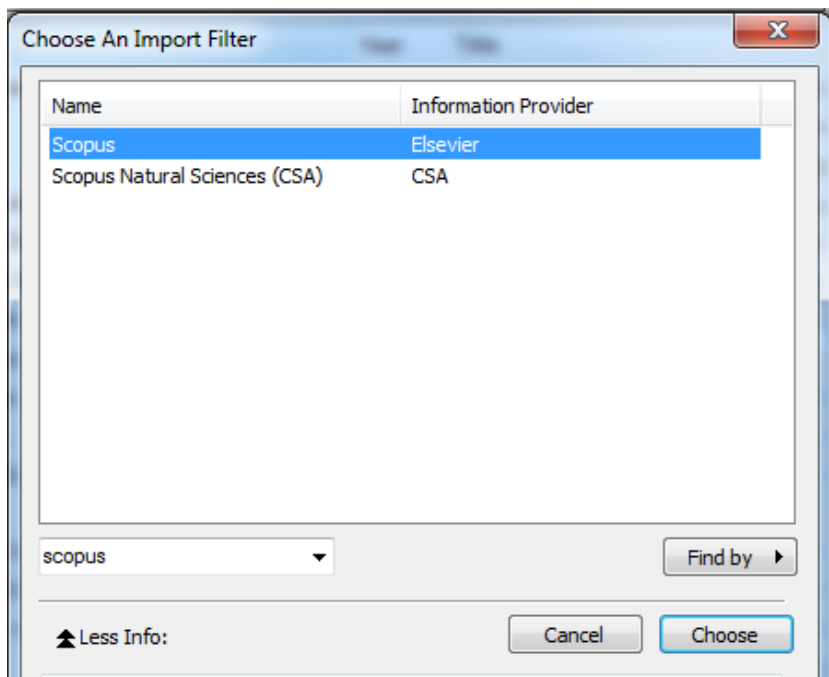
- You will be prompted to **save** or **open** the ris file
- If you open the file directly with the EndNote programme, the references will be automatically imported into your EndNote library
- If you save the ris file, you have to import the references by yourself

Step 4 - Import to Endnote

- Open the Endnote library, that you would like to import the records to. Then select from the top bar menu: **File > Import > File**
- Choose the ris file that you have saved just now.
- Choose the appropriate filter. If Scopus is not on the list, select "Other Filters"



- Locate Scopus from the list or type in Scopus in the search box and press Enter to locate an appropriate filter. Then click on Choose



- Select Import All. (to remove identical records, select Discard Duplicates)
- The records will be duly imported into the selected Endnote library.
